## THE GALT HOUSE HOTEL RENOVATION FACT SHEET

### BY THE NUMBERS:

- 100: percent complete as of October 2020
- 700: jobs supported by the project
- 1,239: guest rooms complete
- 130,000: square feet of meeting space renovated
- \$80 million: total investment
- 40: percentage increase in speed of elevators
- 17,897: square feet of bar and restaurant space renovated as of September 2020
- 8,686: total square feet Walker's Exchange
- 2,000: total square feet Jockey Silks Bourbon Bar
- 7,211: total square feet Swizzle Dinner & Drinks
- 7,925: total square feet The Conservatory

### SUSTAINABILITY FEATURES:

- All lighting in renovated areas updated to LED
- Air-conditioning units in West Tower rooms have been replaced with more efficient systems
- Aging and non-functional systems replaced with high-efficiency systems
- Window glazing, where replaced, has been updated to insulated glazing with low-emission coatings
- In all East Tower guest rooms, single pane residential windows will be replaced with insulated aluminum window systems

### RENOVATION HIGHLIGHTS:

- Introduction of Walker's Exchange, a chef-driven Kentucky brasserie on the second floor of the West Tower
- Reimagining of Jockey Silks, one of Louisville's oldest bourbon bars
- West Tower suites, featuring sweeping views of the city/riverfront, upgraded to include 65-inch TVs, wet bars, and sleeper sofas
- Third floor meeting space in West Tower all upgraded, including the Willow Room, which includes balcony access overlooking the Belvedere and can accommodate up to 1,000 people

- Conservatory featuring our updated media wall with 9 LED Flat screen TVs, and the longest bar in Louisville.
